(a) Any active or retired commissioned officer or warrant officer of any component of the United States Army who is or at any time was assigned or attached to the 77th Regional Readiness Command (RRC), the 77th Regional Support Command (RSC), the 77th Army Reserve Command (ARCOM), the 77th Infantry Division or 77th Infantry Division (RTU), or to any of their subordinate or attached units, who in the case of any transfer out of such unit is then in good standing, and who is not eligible to become a Regular Member pursuant to Section 2 of this ARTICLE I, shall be eligible to become an Associate Member of the Association and shall be admitted as such upon the submission and acceptance of his or her application therefor and payment of the first installment of his or her initiation fee, as hereinafter provided....”
